JAMESTOWN 4-H CENTER

A youth facility located on 16 acres along the James River near the historical Jamestown settlement in Virginia. The facility has served as a summer camp for 4-H'ers in eastern Virginia since 1946. The Center is located five miles from Williamsburg and one mile from the Jamestown Festival Park. The 4-H Center is noted for its serenity and beauty - a place for relaxing and having fun.

FACILITIES

Include air conditioned lodges and cabins, dining hall, recreation hall, clinic with EMT on duty, pool, and aquatic resource center. Paved basketball courts, playing field for soccer, volleyball, and softball. Outdoor amphitheater and pavilion.

STAFF

4-H Camp staff, Extension agents, and trained volunteer leaders provide camper supervision, instruction, and support.
